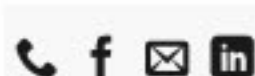


# The Sea Ray Fly 510 and Sundancer 320, built for your pleasure

With some 60 years of expertise in building marine pleasure craft, you could say that American manufacturer **Sea Ray** knows a thing or two about them. It's hard to pick highlights from its catalogue of nearly 50 models, but *Sundancer 320* and *Fly 510* stand out.

The *Sundancer's* overall length is just 10m, but it has a three-metre beam and a host of smart features. You'll find an integrated swim platform, plus ample social space in the form of a wraparound lounge in the cockpit area, bow lounge and an optional sun pad.

Staying in for the night? The spacious cabin accommodates up to four guests with a pair of twin bunks convertible to a queen-sized bed. The microwave and fridge-equipped galley also means you won't go hungry.

On that note, the Sea Ray *Fly 510* is hard to beat. A 15m craft, it's as plush – and as roomy, thanks to the added room accorded by its flybridge – as a modern luxury apartment. A full-beam master stateroom also adds to the feeling of having a home away from home.

With social and private spaces spanning three decks, along with a fully equipped galley, the *Fly* makes weekend getaways a breeze.
